Chris Davis is president of Raytheon International, Incorporated (RII), responsible for the company's sales and marketing efforts in more than 80 nations worldwide. International business accounts for over 30 percent of Raytheon's total sales. A retired United States Marine Corps officer and aviator, Davis joined Raytheon in 2006 after a 20-year military career. Prior to being selected to head RII, he held several positions instrumental to Raytheon's Business Development in the Middle East and North Africa (MENA). While in the military, Davis served three years in Japan and was a finalist for the Council on Foreign Relations' International Affairs Fellow Japan. He is a combat aviator with more than 2,000 flight hours in both rotary and fixed-wing (fighter) aircraft. Davis holds a bachelor's degree in industrial economics from Union College in Schenectady New York, and a master's degree in security studies from the Marine Corps University.
