**Cyber Operations – a legal and technological
challenge**

Brigadier-general Paul Ducheine (1965) is a Professor for Cyber Operations and Cyber Security at the Netherlands Defence Academy and a Professor in the Law of Cyber Warfare at the University of Amsterdam.

Ducheine started his military career in 1983 at the Royal Military Academy and joined the Engineer Regiment (as a combat engineer) in 1987. In 1998 he joined the Army Legal Service.

Prof. Ducheine holds degrees in Political Sciences (Amsterdam Free University, 1993) and Law (University of Utrecht, 1998). In 2008 he defended his PhD-thesis *Armed Forces, Use of Force and Counter-Terrorism. A study of the legal aspects of the role of the armed forces in combating terror* (org. Dutch) at the University of Amsterdam.

He is one of the editors of *Cyber Warfare: Critical Perspectives* – NL ARMS 2012, TMC Asser Press (2012), and *Fighting without killing*, NLARMS 2017, TMC Asser Press/Springer Verlag (2017). With Mike Schmitt (US Naval War College) and Frans Osinga (NLDA) he edited *Targeting: Challenges of Modern Warfare* (2015, TMC Asser Press).
