Robin Geiß is Professor of International Law and Security at the University of Glasgow and visiting professor at the Paris School of International Affairs at Sciences Po, Paris. A former Legal Adviser of the International Committee of the Red Cross (ICRC), Robin Geiß is editor of the Yearbook of International Humanitarian Law and a member of the international group of experts working on the “Woomera Manual on International Law of Military Space Operations”.

Previously, he was a member of the international group of experts that drafted the “Tallinn Manual on Cyber Warfare” under the auspices of the NATO Cooperative Cyber Defence Centre of Excellence in Tallinn, director of the “Security Governance in Areas of Limited Statehood”-project at the “Sonderforschungsbereich 700” at Freie Universität Berlin, and Rapporteur of the International Law Association’s (ILA) Study Group on the law applicable to the conduct of hostilities in 21st century warfare.

In addition to his academic work, Professor Geiß has advised international organizations and states, inter alia, in proceedings before the International Court of Justice (ICJ) and on matters pertaining to new (military) technologies and cyber security. He is a member of the Scientific Advisory Board of the Stiftung Wissenschaft und Politik (SWP), the Lieber Prize Committee of the American Society of International Law and the German National Committee on International Humanitarian Law.
