Human Resources – backbone of armed forces

Peter Geluk is a Partner & Managing Director in the Amsterdam office of The Boston Consulting Group. He leads the Public Sector practice of BCG in The Netherlands, and is responsible for this practice in Western Europe and Africa. Peter maintains relationships with BCG's key clients in the (semi) public sector, with a focus on Infrastructure & Mobility, Safety & Security, Aid & Trade and Public Media.

In 2012 Peter led a review of the sourcing program of the Dutch Ministry of Defense, looking at strategy & objectives, roles & responsibilities, processes & skills and behaviour & communication. The review identified four core issues and presented fifteen recommendations to improve the effectiveness of the sourcing program. In 2014 Peter was involved in a value-for-money assessment of different weapon systems of the Dutch armed forces. Part of the assessment focused on quantifying the potential of international cooperation and integrated contracting. Recently (2018) Peter delivered an international benchmark of practices that aim to make armed forces more adaptive. In this international study the team researched practices related to industry collaboration, 21st century career tracks and flexibility, and cultural transformation.

Peter obtained an MPA degree from Leiden University and specialised in financial management of the Public Sector.
