Holding degrees in philosophy (BA, MA, PhD), law (LLB, LLM), and political science (PhD), he is the author of more than 15 books, and a member of the Academic Advisory Board of NATO Defense College. In September 2018, he will publish a governmental report on disinformation, and a CSIS report on the Macron Leaks.
