**Cyber Security Architecture – a national, European

Uku Särekanno was born on 18th February 1981 in Tartu.

After graduating studies in Tallinn University (Public Administration) he started working for the Estonian Government Office, responsible for European Council preparations and development of the EU document management system (2004-2007). In 2006 he was posted to the Cabinet of the European Commission Vice-President Siim Kallas for 5 month in-service training.

During 2007 to 2013 Uku Särekanno served as Member of the Management Board of the Estonian Ministry of Interior and was posted to the Estonian Permanent Representation to the EU as Counsellor on police cooperation, migration and large scale IT-systems. During 2014 – 2015 Uku Särekanno worked as Head of Law Enforcement and Criminal Policy Department in the Estonian Ministry of the Interior.

During 2015- 2017 Uku Särekanno worked as Head of Staff and Presidency Team in the Estonian Permanent Representation and coordinated preparations for the Estonian Presidency of the Council of the EU. During the time of the Estonian Presidency of the Council Uku Särekanno served as a member of the EU Brexit negotiation team (Task Force 50) supporting EU Chief Negotiator Michel Barnier.

As from 2018 Uku Särekanno serves as Deputy Director General and Director of Cyber Security in the Estonian Information System Authority.
