**Resilience – how to cope with future multilevel
threats?**

HP Schreinemachers is director for Analysis and Strategy at the office of the National Coordinator for Security and Counterterrorism (NCTV) in the Netherlands.

The Analysis and Strategy Department (DAS) has at all times the most complete and up-to-date overview possible of threats and risks to Dutch national security. This enables it to supply timely, high-quality threat-related products (such as threat and risk analyses, scenarios and studies). It works and consults with other parties within and outside the organization, providing a solid information basis for the NCTV's work. In addition, DAS is responsible for designing core strategies in the area of national security, counterterrorism and cyber security. The department also coordinates and oversees the international relations and legal affairs of the NCTV.

He was appointed in his current position in August 2015. From 2010-2015 he was counselor for Justice and Home Affairs at the Netherlands embassy in Washington, DC. Previously he was the deputy and acting Director for Migration Policy at the Ministry of Justice. During the period 2001-2005 Schreinemachers fulfilled various management positions at the Immigration- and Naturalisation Service, including Head of the implementation policy department.

Schreinemachers studied Political Sciences (with focus on International Relations) and Law (both Dutch and International Law).
