After having received his master degree in Aerospace Engineering (1984) at the “Universität der Bundeswehr München” (University of the Federal Armed Forces, Munich) and military training at the German Air Force Air Defense School in Fort Bliss, Texas, USA, Heiko Seebode served as a German SAM officer in the NATO Integrated Air Defence System, later on in the Programming Centre of the “Luftwaffe” (German Air Force).
