PESCO – a major step ahead for Europe’s Security!?

Dr Sergiu Vintila has been policy advisor to Professor Ioan Mircea Pascu MEP, Vice-President of the European Parliament since 2009. Dr Vintila’s professional career started as researcher at the Romanian Academy. He held positions of lecturer and Associate Professor until 2002 and since 2006 at the National School of Political Studies and Public Administration (SNSPA) in Bucharest and, since 2013 at the University of Luxembourg. Between 2001 and 2009 he held senior management positions in the Ministry of Defence of Romania, including as Director of the Defence Policies Directorate and Defence Advisor - minister counsellor, Permanent Delegation of Romania to NATO, Brussels. Since 1990, he has taught various courses, mostly for postgraduate students, in International Relations Theory, Security and Strategic Studies and EU in World Affairs at SNSPA in Bucharest, at the NATO School, Oberammergau and the University of Luxembourg. Dr Vintila has been a Member of the Royal College of Defence Studies (RCDS) since 2008 and an associate fellow of the Institute of Political Studies in Luxembourg since 2014.
