**Digitization – Challenges of future multinational operations**

Since 2013 Dr. Gerhard van der Giet is Senior Consultant to Computacenter in the defence domain. In his last appointment from August 2008 until NATO's Agency Reform he was General Manager of the NATO Air Command and Control System Management Agency (NACMA), responsible for the development of a NATO-wide common Air Operations System (ACCS) and the development of an ACCS-amendment for missile defence.

From 2002 until 2008 Dr. van der Giet was CIO of the German Federal Armed Forces in the MoD. His responsibilities included the definition of requirements, system development and integration, procurement and maintenance of IT-Systems as well as information assurance. Among major projects were the Public Private Partnership Project HERKULES and the implementation of a Federal Armed Forces standard application software (SAP). Subordinated were the "Federal Office for Information Management and Information Technology" as planning and procurement agency, and the "IT-Centre" for testing. He was the German representative to NATO C3 Board and Principal in NATO C3 SNR.

Dr. van der Giet began his career as scientist in projects of the MoD at the University of Bonn. Follow on places of employment were at the Federal Criminal Police Office (BKA) in Wiesbaden and the Federal German Parliament, in IT and as secretary of a parliamentary body. He was IT-Consultant to foreign national Parliaments and managed projects in international cooperation.

He holds doctorates of the University of Bonn in Physics and the Faculty of Philosophy.
