Dr. Veronika Bock studied theology at the University of Würzburg and worked as a research associate (Department of Peace and Social Ethics) at the Helmut Schmidt University, University of the Federal Armed Forces in Hamburg. For her doctoral thesis on the consequences of grave human rights violations at the University of Münster she received the PhD Award "Religion and Ethics", University of Erfurt and the Science Prize of the University of Münster. Dr. Bock is the director of the Center for Ethical Education in the Armed Forces (zebis) in Hamburg since 2010. She is regularly engaged in seminars and lectures for the "Master of Peace and Security Studies" at the Institute for Peace Research and Security Policy (IFSH), University of Hamburg and in other contexts in Germany and abroad and has published articles on human rights, peace ethics, current issues of military ethics (digitization and autonomization processes in the armed forces).
