PESCO – a major step of the EU Defence Strategy

Lucio Demichele is an Italian career diplomat.

Since July 2016, he has been Head of the EU CFSP-CSDP Unit at the Italian Ministry of Foreign Affairs. His current duties comprise the coordination and preparation of the Italian participation in the Foreign Affairs Council meetings, support and advice to the Political Director on CSDP matters (including the development of European Defense), oversight of civilian CSDP Italian policies and direct management of the network of independent experts deployed in civilian CSDP missions.

He served in Frankfurt am Main (Germany) as Deputy Consul General; in Bucharest (Romania) as Press and Political Officer; in Ankara (Turkey), as Counsellor for Political Affairs; at the Italian Representation to NATO in Brussels, as First Counsellor responsible for Nuclear, Disarmament and Non Proliferation, NATO-Russia relationship, and Defense and Policy Planning.
