Krzysztof Mischczak – Professor Extraordinarius, Institute of International Studies at the Warsaw School of Economics. A foreign policy, EU common security and defence policy expert and advisor. Counsellor general at the Chancellery of the Prime Minister of Poland.

Obtained a master's degree in political science, a doctoral degree in philosophy at the Ludwig Maximilian University of Munich and a post-doctoral degree in social sciences at the Adam Mickiewicz University. He held a number of senior positions including the Counsellor and Minister Plenipotentiary, Deputy Polish Ambassador in the Federal Republic of Germany (1996-2001), Director of European Security Policy Department at the MFA (2001–2002). He was the Director of Foreign Affairs Department and Director of International Policy Department in the Chancellery of the Prime Minister of Poland (2005-2007), Director of the Office of the Prime Minister's Plenipotentiary for International Dialogue (2008-2013). During the years 2011-2016 he was the chairman of the Polish-German Forum, Director and member of the Board of the Foundation for Polish-German Cooperation (2013-2016), Chairman of the Board of the Foundation for Polish-German Reconciliation (2011-2018).
