Major General Mohan assumed command of the 21st Theater Sustainment Command on July 31, 2019. The mission of the 21st Theater Sustainment Command is to exercise mission command for strategic and operational sustainment operations across the EUCOM AOR; execute theater opening, theater distribution, and theater sustainment in support of EUCOM and NATO operations; and, as directed, support AFRICOM operations in order to enable Allied victory.

MG Christopher O. Mohan is a native of Carthage, North Carolina. He commissioned into the United States Army in 1989 from Appalachian State University in Boone, North Carolina where he graduated as a Distinguished Military Graduate with a Bachelor of Science Degree in Criminal Justice. His military education includes the Ordnance Officer Basic Course, the Combined Logistics Officer Advanced Course, the Naval College of Command and Staff and the Army War College. He holds a Master of Science in National Security and Strategic Studies from the Naval War College and a Master's Degree in Military Strategy from the Army War College.
